Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.143 dated 13.6.2019, registered under Sections 376, 506 IPC and Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (lateron converted into Section 376-D, 506, 363 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 was added), at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the petitioner was granted regular bail and thereafter, offence under Section 376-D was added and hence, he deserves to be granted anticipatory bail. However, after arguing for some time, he prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to surrender before the Court concerned.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

In case, the petitioner surrenders and files an appropriate application before the Court concerned within 7 days from today, the Court

concerned is requested to decide his application for grant of bail expeditiously preferably within 3 days from the date of filing of the same.
