The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the Police to not harass the petitioner and her family members. A further reference is made to certain antecedents and also to the report of SIT furnished to this Court on 01.05.2017 to submit that the Investigating agency has a tendency to falsely rope in the petitioner. It is submitted that the FIR No.9 dated 20.01.2022 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 has already been registered at Police Station Garhdiwal, District Hoshiarpur and under the garb of said FIR, the petitioner and his family members are being harassed.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to an appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
