The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 to take necessary steps as respondents No.4 and 5 i.e. police officers putting pressure upon the petitioner and her husband on behest of respondents No.6 and 7 to withdraw the Civil Suit CS/480/2021 (Annexure P-1) titled as “***Somnath Versus Harwinder Singh and Another***”, pending in the Court of Additional Civil Judge Senior Division, Nakodar against the respondents No.5 and 7, otherwise they will be falsely implicated in false criminal case.

Notices served upon the official respondents through the State's counsel. Given the nature of the order that this Court proposes to pass, neither the response of official respondents nor the issuance of notices to the private respondents is required.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case directions may be issued to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar to decide representation dated

17.01.2022 (Annexure P-4) within time bound manner.

The prayer is not opposed.

Given above, respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar to decide representation dated 17.01.2022 (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking and reasoned order within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

Petition is allowed to the extent mentioned above.

Pending application if any, also stands disposed of.
