Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.195 dated 24.11.2012 registered under Section 174-A IPC at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Affidavit of the petitioner – Jasvir Singh, filed in the Court is taken on record as Mark X.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that during the pendency of a complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, the petitioner has compromised the matter with the complainant and he was under the impression that on the next date of hearing, the complainant will withdraw the complaint, however, the complaint was not withdrawn and the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person and the trial Court directed to register the present FIR.

As per the affidavit of the petitioner, filed in the Court today, the complainant had already moved an application for withdrawal of the complaint, filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.
