1. Prayer made in the instant petition, cast under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is that complaint bearing No. NACT-136 of 8.11.2019, pending before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ganaur, be quashed, and, a further prayer is made for the quashing of the summoning order dated 8.11.2019, passed by the learned Magistrate concerned.

However, the above made prayers become completely rendered infructuous, as today, the learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the order dated 9.6.2020, drawn by the learned Magistrate concerned, a perusal whereof reveals, that on the anvil of a statement made before him by the complainant, qua his intending to withdraw the petition complaint, the learned Magistrate concerned, hence proceeding to dismiss it as withdrawn.
