Prayer in this application is for placing on record the submissions by way of affidavit along with document Annexure R-2/1.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Affidavit along with document Annexure R-2/1 is taken on record.

Main case

The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, praying for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing impugned order dated 18.01.2021 (Annexure P8), whereby representation filed by the petitioner seeking primarily relief of

renewing/extending the service tenure of the petitioner by adding his name in the list of similar situated contractual employees has been denied. Further, prayer has been made for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondents to renew/extend service tenure of the petitioner.

As per the case of respondents No. 2 to 4, services of the petitioner had to be terminated because of non-extension of his contract of service. It has also been pointed out by counsel for respondents No. 2 to 4 that after termination of services of the petitioners, an advertisement for fresh recruitment for the said engagement has already been issued and process of selection is going on.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has also applied in pursuance to the said advertisement.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere in the matter.

Resultantly, the instant writ petition is dismissed.
