Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0262, dated 08.09.2020 registered under Section 394 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Uchana, District Jind, Haryana.

Vide order dated 17.02.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Ramesh Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation. Recovery has already been effected from him.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, petition is allowed and the order dated 17.02.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
