The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos.6 and 7.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.7 (son of respondent No.7) has been serving as Head Constable in Punjab Police and that respondent No.7 is trying to implicate the petitioner and his other family members in a false NDPS case. He further submits that the petitioner has already moved representations dated 15.03.2021, 11.05.2021 and 27.01.2022 (Annexures P-1, P-3 and P-5), respectively but till date no action has been taken upon the same.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if the aforesaid representations are ordered to be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 5.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5.

Keeping in view the limited prayer sought for and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, it would be just and appropriate to direct respondent No.2-Director General of Police Crime, Punjab, to look into the grievance of the petitioner and decide the representations dated 27.01.2022 in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
