The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for the promotion as a 'Punjabi Lecturer' from due date alongwith all consequential benefits, for which, representations dated 12.03.2021, 08.04.2021 and 05.01.2022 (Annexures P-13 to P-15, respectively) have also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the representations dated 12.03.2021, 08.04.2021 and 05.01.2022 (Annexures P-13 to P-15, respectively) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay.
