The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.602 dated 05.10.2021 under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC registered at Police Station City Sonipat.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that order dated 31.03.2022 has been complied with. The said fact has been admitted by the counsel for the complainant and further submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 17.02.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 17.02.2022 and

is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 17.02.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
