The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 12 dated 10.01.2020 under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code (Section 201 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, neither the complainant nor his wife Harwinder Kaur who had identified the present petitioner, have been examined in the present case.

In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition at this stage with liberty to file fresh after the said two persons have been examined.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

The trial Court is requested to expeditiously examine the complainant- Kala Singh and his wife Harwinder Kaur.

It is made clear that when the fresh petition is filed, the same would be considered independently on its merits in accordance with law.
