Instant petition had been filed under Section 482 CrPC for seeking quashing of FIR No.111 dated 12.07.2018, under Sections 420 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Division No.2 Jalandhar, District Jalandhar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 17.09.2018 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

A perusal of the file would show that upon institution of the case, the same was listed on board on 08.02.2019, when a request for adjournment was made by the counsel for the petitioner. The matter was adjourned to 11.02.2019, when the same request was repeated and the case stood adjourned to 18.03.2019. Even on the said date, the matter was adjourned. On 12.04.2019, written request for adjournment was received on behalf of the petitioner and the matter was adjourned to 04.07.2019. However, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 14.07.2019 as well. It was accordingly adjourned in the interest of justice to 24.09.2019. On the said date, learned counsel for the petitioner earlier sought a pass-over and then he did not turn up, the case was again adjourned to

21.11.2019. Nobody preferred to put an appearance on the said date as well. The case was then adjourned to 15.01.2020, however there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on that date as well and the matter was adjourned to 29.04.2020. The matter was eventually listed for 25.03.2022, however, there was no representation on the said date as well. Today also, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that the petitioner is not interest in pursuing the instant petition.

Hence, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
