This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.164 dated 16.10.2019 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 at Police Station Cantonment, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.
