This is a first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR no.227 dated 21.10.2021 registered under Section 324, 326, 341, 148, 149 and 506 IPC and Sections 25, 54 Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks to withdraw the present petition and states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the police within a period of 10 days from today and prays that in case the petitioner applies for regular bail after surrender, the trial Court be directed to decide the same as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 5 days.

Keeping in view the above said statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn,

with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the police within a period of 10 days and in case after surrendering, the petitioner files an application for regular bail, the trial Court is directed to decide the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of 7 days from the date of the said application being moved.
