This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the FIR No.0041 dated 01.08.2019 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 465, 469 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpura, District Rupnagar, Punjab as well as consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 09.02.2021 (Annexure P-2).
