Petitioners have approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.81 dated 07.06.2021 under Sections 341, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 (later on added Section 307) of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar, Kotkapura, District Faridkot, who apprehends their arrest at the hands of Police.

On 21.02.2022, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon the order dated 21.12.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by this Court in CRM-M-52527-2021.

Notice of motion for 17.03.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the

investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-52527-2021.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioners associated themselves in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by SI Lakhwinder Singh states that indeed the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 21.02.2022 is made absolute.
