The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of issuance of appropriate writ directing respondents to pay the arrears of revised pay scale to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.01.2006 to 31.07.2009 and to release the arrears of pay as per 6th Pay Commission w.e.f. 01.01.2006 till 31.07.2009 and further to pay interest @ 18% per annum for unduly delaying the rightful and justified salary arrears of the petitioner, for which, legal notice dated 18.11.2021 (Annexure P/9) has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider legal notice dated 18.11.2021 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay.
