The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.236 dated 12.12.2021 registered under Sections 120-B, 313, 323, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC at Police Station, Kalka, District Panchkula.

By virtue of the order dated 22.4.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to order dated 22.4.2022 petitioner has duly joined the investigation. He submits that parties appeared before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this court, however, same remained unsuccessful on account of the adamant behaviour of the respondent wife.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by counsel for petitioner and submits that mediation proceedings remained unsuccessful on account of non-cooperative behaviour of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has submitted that in pursuance to order dated 22.4.2022 petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation. However, he submits that recovery of some of the dowry articles is yet to be effected.

In view of the above, the order dated 22.4.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
