HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.206 dated 31.10.2021, registered at Police Station East, Sector 26, Chandigarh, under Section 307 IPC (Section 212 IPC added later on) and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Vide orders dated 04.04.2022 and 01.08.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid orders, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel appearing for UT Chandigarh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation, but as the co-accused is confined in Ferozepur Jail, the investigating agency intends to call him again for further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 04.04.2022 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

However, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when, he is called by the investigating agency.
