The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

The age of petitioner No.2 is stated to be 18 years and 3 months and an objection has been raised by the Registry to the effect that the affidavit of petitioner No.2 is not forthcoming. Instead of filing an affidavit of petitioner No.2, petitioner No.2 who is major although not of marriageable age, has filed the present petition through his father. Neither the affidavit of petitioner No.2 has been annexed with the present

petition nor petitioner No.2 has filed his power of attorney.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Criminal Writ Petition with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh petition after rectifying all the said mistakes.

In view of the above, the present Criminal Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
