Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.57 dated 17.05.2019, Annexure P-1, registered for offences under Sections 323, 452, 354-D, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short "IPC"), however, later on Sections 324, 307, 354 and 354-B, IPC were added and Section 354-D, IPC was deleted vide GDR No.27 dated 21.07.2020, Annexure P-2, at Police Station Mullanpur Garib Dass, District Mohali, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 09.01.2021, Annexure P-3, arrived at between the parties.

Faced with the observations made by this Court in order dated 16.08.2021, counsel for the petitioners seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
