The grievance of the petitioner as raised in the representation dated 09.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) is not being looked into by the Police. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the items which were lying in the house of the petitioner, was taken away by the private respondents after trespassing over the property of the petitioner and the said grievance has been raised by the petitioner by filing representation before the Police Authority on 09.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) but, despite expiry of more than three months, no action has been taken so far by the Police. Learned counsel submits that as of now, the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

service of advance copy of petition accepts notice on behalf of respondents-

State and states that the representation dated 09.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner will be decided within a period of eight weeks from today and in case, after the decision of the said representation, it is found that any action needs to be taken, the same will also be taken without any further delay.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, is directed to decide representation dated 09.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

It is made clear that the representation, be decided after associating all the persons who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the representation.

Present petition stands disposed of.
