The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of interim bail in FIR No.218 dated 19.06.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 3 of the Haryana Protection of Interest of Depositors in Financial Establishment Act, 2013 at Police Station Rewari City, District Rewari.

The petitioner, who is presently in custody in District Jail, Panipat, on the death of his father, seeks interim bail to immerse his ashes.

On one hand, the petitioner is the only son of his father who is there to immerse his father's ashes while on the other hand, he faces seven FIRs and in the present case his brother is absconding.

Keeping in view the afore circumstances, the applicant is permitted to immerse his father's ashes. Accordingly, before the sunrise of February 25, 2022, the relatives of the petitioner shall bring his father's ashes to District Jail, Panipat from where, after taking all security measures, in police custody, the police shall take the petitioner to Garh Ganga, Uttar Pradesh so that the petitioner can perform all necessary religious rituals with

regard to immersion of his father's ashes. After the needful has been done, the petitioner shall be brought back on the same day and housed in the jail before sunset. All expenses for the above arrangement shall be borne by the petitioner.
