The appellant has come up in appeal against the judgment and decree dated 20.12.2018 whereby petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce was partly allowed.

Vide order dated 28.09.2022, the matter was referred before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and with the assistance of Mr. Sachin Jain, Advocate as Mediator, the parties have reached to an amicable settlement. The conditions of the settlement have been reduced into writing in settlement agreement dated 28.09.2022 and the same is taken on record. Parties are present in Court today and they have made their respective statements which are also taken on record. As per the statement of the appellant, she states that respondent-husband has paid a sum of Rs.5 lacs, by way of cheque No. 094112 dated 28.09.2022 drawn on Axis Bank Limited Ludhiana, in favour of Gurmanjot Singh Sidhu-son. She will not defame or malign the image of the respondent or his family members and no

dispute is pending with regard to alimony/maintenance. The respondent has also made a statement to this effect.

Keeping in view the settlement agreement dated 28.09.2022 and the statements made by both the parties, the appellant wishes to withdraw the instant appeal.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
