This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the order dated 13.12.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib, declaring the petitioner proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition and further states that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and prays that in case the petitioner applies for regular bail thereafter, the trial Court be directed to decide the regular bail application, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 05 days.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and in case the petitioner applies for regular bail thereafter, the trial

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Court be directed to decide the regular bail application, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 05 days.
