[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 30.08.2019 in CRM-M No.36096 of 2019 in case titled as Pawan Kumar vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CRM-M No.36096 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the Superintendent of Police, Karnal to look into representation dated 21.06.2019 and to take action as required, if any, as per law.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in compliance of order, Annexure P/1, representation of the petitioner has been decided and action as was required in respect thereto, has been taken vide order, Annexure R/2 dated 30.05.2022 and that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of

as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
