The petitioner is an organization of the employees of the Roadways, Haryana. They complain wilful violation of the directions issued on 18.07.2019, passed in CWP-18849-2019. A bunch of writ petitions was decided by a common order. While allowing, the writ petition, the following directions were issued:-

“Keeping in view the aforementioned stand, Department intends to redress grievance of petitioners and all other affected persons to whom benefit is to be extended. I dispose of writ petition with direction to abide by instructions annexed with affidavit and take decision in a most pragmatic and reasonable manner and if necessity arises, an opportunity of personal hearing to affected persons can also be afforded.

In view of aforementioned observations and undertaking given in affidavit, writ petitions are disposed of.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sh. Satish Kumar, Accountant, office of State Transport Department, Haryana, submits that necessary relief has been granted and a reply in this regard has also been filed.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedy for certain employees who have not been granted the benefit.

Ordered accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
