Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. directions are sought to the State to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner/her family members which is allegedly under threat at the hands of respondent No.5, who after having allegedly raped the petitioner is threatening her to compromise the matter.

In response to the notice issued by this Court, the State has filed an affidavit as per which, on the complaint of rape made by the petitioner a FIR was registered against respondent No.5, after investigation of which the State has found the petitioner's claim to be false and accordingly a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the State before the Trial Court seeking cancellation of the aforesaid FIR.

In view of the above development, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the

petitioner to avail of her remedy before the competent Court to oppose the cancellation report which already stands filed by the State.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
