Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are the widow and minor children of the deceased, who had expired in a road accident. They had preferred a claim petition and the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Karnal ('Tribunal' - for short) (respondent No. 1) passed an award in their favour on 31.07.2019. The award has attained finality, as it was not challenged by either of the parties. They had preferred an execution petition, which is pending adjudication for over three year and the petitioners are without any means of sustenance. He submits that the Tribunal may be directed to decide the execution petition in a time bound manner.

Heard. In view of the above, I am disposing of this petition without issuance of notice to the respondents with a direction to the Tribunal (respondent No.1) to conclude the execution proceedings expeditiously, but not later than six months from now.
