Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.131 dated 11.09.2021, registered under Sections 307, 323, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25, 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner and that Section 307 IPC has been added only to make the offence non-bailable. He further submits that as per MLR No.10/HS/BBK/2021 dated 10.09.2021 pertaining to Ranjit Kaur, the concerned Doctor has specifically opined that all the 04 injuries on her person were blunt and recommended X-ray and that DBL riffle could not cause blunt injuries.

The status report filed on behalf of the respondent-State is already on record.

Learned State counsel submits that as per the status report, there were as many as four injuries on the person of the complainant and it was the petitioner who was armed with deadly weapon i.e. DBBL gun of his father and had fired gun shots towards the complainant party with an intention to kill them.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through paper-book.

There are serious allegations against the petitioner that he was armed with DBBL gun of his father and had fired gun shots upon the complainant party with intention to kill them, whereupon the complainant had received as many as four injuries.

Considering the very nature of the allegations contained in the FIR, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is a must. Hence, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
