This is the second petition for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 249 dated 20.10.2018 registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and, thus, he was granted anticipatory bail by this Court. Thereafter he was appearing regularly but on a particular day on account of miscommunication with the counsel he did not appear and, thus, bail bonds were cancelled. Keeping in view the circumstances, he may be granted anticipatory bail.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and waives service.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 23.02.2022 and apply for regular bail. In case he does so, the trial Court shall decide the same as expeditiously as possible and in any case not later than three days from the date of filing of the application.
