On 18.02.2022, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner has approached this Court with a prayer to extend his furlough. It is submitted that the petitioner has availed two weeks' furlough and has to surrender on 19.02.2022. The marriage of his sister, namely, Archana is fixed for 28.02.2022. His elder brother-Mahender being a specially abled person and his parents being old aged are unable to make arrangement of the marriage of his sister. He, therefore, prays for extension of furlough for three weeks.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Counsel for the State is directed to seek instructions and verify the assertions as have been made in the present petition. Affidavit/response, if any, be filed on or before the next date of hearing.

List for consideration on 22.02.2022.

Till then, surrender of the petitioner shall stand deferred.”

In pursuance to the said order, reply has been received through email from the counsel for the State of Haryana, according to which the factual assertions, as have been recorded above, stand acknowledged.

In the light of the above, we extend the period of furlough of the petitioner and he is now directed to surrender on **02.03.2022** before the jail authorities.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
