GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.47 dated 08.07.2019 registered at Police Station Ladhuwal, District Ludhiana, under Sections 336/506/34 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 07.02.2020, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioner, namely, Mohan Singh and Manpreet Singh @ Monu and also of complainant Kulwinder Singh @ Kinda have

been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Kulwinder Singh in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise without any coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.47 dated 08.07.2019 registered at Police Station Ladhuwal, District Ludhiana, under Sections 336/506/34 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
