[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 09.12.2020, in CWP No.21118 of 2020 in case titled as '**Jarnail Singh versus The State of Punjab and others.**'

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) dated 09.12.2020, reveals that CWP No.21118 of 2020, was disposed of by directing respondent No.4 to take action on legal notice dated 02.11.2020 and if payment was found due, to release the same to the petitioner within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned counsel states that pursuant to issuance of notice, the respondents have accepted the claim as contained in legal notice dated 02.11.2020 and released payment to the petitioner as per his entitlement, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
