RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the entire service of the petitioners (ad-hoc/temporary/seasonal) till the date of regularization as qualifying service for the purpose of pension and deemed to be in service prior to 01.01.2004.

The counsel for the respondents has submitted that the benefit of old pension scheme has been granted to the petitioners except petitioner No.3. The petitioner No.3 could not be granted the benefit of old pension scheme because he did not complete 10 years of qualifying service. Written statement to that effect has already been filed. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

The fact that the petitioners except petitioner No.3 have been brought under the old pension scheme is not disputed by the counsel for the petitioner. Hence, even the counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as having been rendered as infructuous.

The pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of as such.
