[1] Prayer in the petition under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 16.08.2021 in CWP No.15585 of 2021 whereby directions had been issued to the respondent to consider and decide legal notice dated 11.06.2021 in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within 04 months.

[2] Learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of speaking order dated 11.02.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 11.06.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 11.02.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[4] Admittedly, order dated 11.02.2022 has been passed in compliance of order dated 16.08.2021 in CWP No.15585 of 2021. In the circumstances, no action is called for against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. Contempt petition is *disposed of* as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 11.02.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
