This is petitioner's fourth attempt to get bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR no.79 dated 18.06.2019 registered under Section 22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

The petitioner prays for concession of interim bail on the ground that his son is getting married. As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was found in conscious possession of 6080 capsules/tablets containing a prohibited substance. The total weight thereof is 2242 grams. The aforesaid quantity falls in the category of commercial quantity.

Hence, no ground to grant concession of interim bail or regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Hence, CRM-11645-2022 as well as CRM-M-7824-2022 stand dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
