[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 13.08.2021, in CWP-15508-2021 in case titled as '**Virender Kumar** versus **State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP-15508-2021 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to decide the claim made in the legal notice dated 16.04.2021 within three months of receipt of certified copy of the order, unfettered by the earlier decision dated 24.05.2018.

[3] At the outset, learned DAG, Haryana, refers to order dated 02.09.2022 as per which, the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 16.04.2021 has been rejected. The same is already on record.

who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 02.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
