The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.26 dated 18.02.2021, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC and Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act (Haryana Amendment Bill, 2020) at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa.

Vide order dated 28.02.2022, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation and further directed to hand over his computer, laptop etc. and/or any such other documents as required by the Investigating Officer.

Upon instructions from Inspector Avtar Singh, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the aforesaid orders, the petitioner has joined the investigation and also handed over the relevant equipments. He further submits that further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is admitted to anticipatory bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
