The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to restore the electricity Connection bearing Account No.3002970298 in the name of Sh. N.S. Sahota, installed at House No.61/2, Garden Colony, Jalandhar.

Pursuant to the notice issued by this Court, Sh.Sunpreet Singh, Advocate, has appeared on behalf of Mr.Sehaj Bir Singh, Advocate, for the respondents – PSPCL and has made a statement that the present petition has been rendered infructuous since the electricity connection against the aforesaid account already stands restored.

In view of the statement so made at Bar today by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents – PSPCL, the present petition is disposed as not pressed, at this stage.

Liberty, however, is granted to the petitioner to revive the preset petition in case the aforesaid statement made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents – PSPCL, is found to be factually incorrect.
