The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.204 dated 25.12.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 326, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

The operative part of the order dated 21.02.2022, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that as per allegations in the FIR, though the petitioner is shown to have caused *datar* injury on the right hand of the victim Satnam Singh, however, other accused persons have also caused injuries on his right hand. It is further submitted that the petitioner, to show his bona fide, is ready to pay Rs.25,000/- to the victim towards the medical expenses, without prejudice to his right of defence.

Notice of motion.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in

pursuance to the order dated 21.02.2022, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation. It is further submitted that the petitioner has also paid Rs. 25,000/- to the victim towards his medical expenses.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 21.02.2022, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
