SURESHWAR THAKUR, J.

1. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that though the Collector concerned has ordered for the eviction/ejectment of the persons concerned from the Panchayat Land concerned, but he also submits that the said order has been challenged by the aggrieved before this Court through CWP No.77 of 2021. Therefore, the petitioners, if otherwise permissible under the law, may join the proceedings in CWP (supra).

2. Consequently, with the above liberty, the mandamus as asked for in the writ petition to be made upon the authorities concerned for ejecting/evicting the persons concerned from Panchayat land, is rendered infructuous. Resultantly, the petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

3. All pending application, if any, also stands disposed of, accordingly.
