Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having Criminal Complaint No.151 of 2017 titled UCO Bank Ladwa v. Sagar Singh dated 2.3.2017.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 24.2.2022 passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from SI Raj Kumar has not refuted the same.

On the last date of hearing, it was noticed by this Court that mandatory period of 30 days provided under Section 82 of Cr.P.C. was not given to the accused persons for appearing in the Court concerned from the date of publication of proclamation.

In view of the above as the petitioner has joined the proceedings in the trial Court and the offence under Section 138 of

Negotiable Instruments Act being bailable offence, order of interim bail dated 24.2.2022 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner should appear in the trial Court on each and every date of hearing.

Present petition stands allowed accordingly.
