This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 15, dated 14.01.2021, registered at Police Station "B" Sub-Division, District, Amritsar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 379-B(2)/34 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that other than the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for about 11 months now, with the trial not even having commenced as yet, he has been named as an accused on a confessional statement allegedly made by him in police custody after he was arrested in the context of other FIR registered against him.

Upon query to learned State counsel, he does not deny that as per his instructions, the charge is still to be framed and that the petitioner has been in custody for the past about 11 months.

That being so, in the aforesaid circumstances, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The

petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
