This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondent No. 2 to take necessary steps against respondents No. 3 to 5.

Petitioner had entered into an agreement to sell dated 16.11.2019 with respondent No. 6. It is the case of petitioner that the amount received by her for the said purpose was the earnest money and same was returned to respondent No.6. The petitioner has also filed a civil suit for cancellation of said agreement to sell which is pending.

Respondent No. 7 filed a complaint dated 8.1.2022 against petitioner alleging that he had been cheated by petitioner who has not executed the sale deed. The said complaint was enquired into and recommended to be filed on the ground that the dispute between the parties was purely of civil nature.

It is stated that despite that, repeated complaints are being moved by respondent No. 6 before different authorities and the petitioner is being repeatedly called by police. She is being forced to withdraw the civil suit and threatened otherwise she will be implicated in a false case.

Without in any way opining on the allegations of petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to official respondents that in case, the presence of petitioner is required in connection with any inquiry, complaint or investigation, procedure as contemplated in Code of Criminal procedure be strictly followed.
