The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 to 4 to provide adequate security and protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 to 11; not to raid their house time and again at the behest of said private respondents and further to direct respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P-1) moved by petitioner No.2.

It is submitted that petitioner No.2 solemnized marriage with Rajwinder Kaur, daughter of respondent No.5 on 06.06.2021 against the wishes of private respondents No.5 to 11 and apprehending danger to their life and liberty, approached this Court vide CRWP No.8568 of 2021, wherein vide order dated 09.09.2021, this Court granted protection to petitioner No.2 and Rajwinder Kaur. But the said private respondents are harassing the petitioners and threatening to kill them. One day in the evening, some persons came to the house of petitioners and threatened them that they should send Rajwinder Kaur back to her parental home, otherwise they will implicate the petitioners in a false case. The petitioners

petitioner No.2 has also moved a representation dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, but till date, no action has been taken on the same.

Now, the prayer on behalf of the petitioners is that a direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the representation of petitioner No.2 in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. V.G.Jauhar, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the representation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3–Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to decide the representation dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P-1) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representation to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
