The present petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions in the nature of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned State counsel has submitted reply by way of affidavit of Dharamvir, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Mullanpur, Tehsil Kharar, District S.A.S. Nagar on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 whereby statements of the petitioners have been annexed as Annexures R-1 to R-2 which have been made by them to the effect that at present they do not have any threat and in case there will be any threat, they will move an application before the local police.

Reference is also made to the statements of respondents No. 4 and 5, i.e. Annexures R-3 and R-4 where respondents No. 4 and

5 have stated that they have no objection with respect to the relationship between the petitioners and they will not harass them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the above, the present petition be disposed of with liberty to file a fresh petition in case there is any threat in future to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with aforesaid liberty.
