1. Application is allowed.
2. Documents attached along with the application, are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

At the outset, learned AAG, Punjab, states that in compliance of order Annexure P/1 dated 20.02.2019, decision has been taken on the representations filed by the petitioner holding that no action is required to be taken in the matter by the police on account of the grievance pertaining to a civil dispute, pending before Court. Order dated 08.12.2018, is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that although the order is of a date prior to order Annexure P/1 dated 20.02.2019, yet, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 08.12.2018, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
