1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 25.09.2019, in CWP-27567-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-27567-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide legal notice 25.04.2019 as well as application for change of option from the fixed medical allowance to open medical allowance, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if on decision of the claim, the petitioner was found entitled to any monetary benefits, to pay the same to him within three months thereafter.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, refers to speaking order Annexure R/1 dated 16.10.2020, as per which, the entire amount claimed in the legal notice dated 25.04.2019, has been paid besides the petitioner has been allowed to change his option from fixed medical allowance to open medical allowance.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of needful having been done, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
