This is a petition that has been filed seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the case of the son of the petitioner for appointment under 2% quota in Punjab Police Department as the petitioner fought against terrorism in the State of Punjab.

Pursuant to notice of motion having been issued on 06.02.2019, reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Amrit Sarup, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters, Amritsar dated 06.06.2019 has been filed, wherein a categorical stand has been taken that the petitioner, who had been recruited as a temporary Constable in Punjab Police, remained absent when he was detailed for training and due to his absence, a departmental inquiry was held and following due procedure, petitioner was dismissed from service with effect from 17.08.2002 and, therefore, as a dismissed employee, the case of the son of

the petitioner could not be considered.

Faced with the reply, learned counsel for the petitioner herein does not press the instant writ petition seeking liberty to avail the alternative remedy, if possible.

Consequently, the instant writ petition is dismissed as not pressed.
